## AFFILIATED CHURCHES OF THE CONFERENCE SHALL BE ENTITLED TO REPRESENTATION AS FOLLOWS:

- Churches with 99 members of less, two delegates
- Churches with 100 through 199 members, three delegates
- Churches with 200 through 299 members, four delegates
- Churches over 300 members, five delegates

**AFFILIATED AGENCIES** are provided two (2) delegates to the meeting. Often this has been the Executive Director and a member of the Board, often the Treasurer (who can address the financials) or the Board President. *This applies to Pilgrim Pines and New England Seafarers* 

**AFFILIATED ASSOCIATIONS** are provided 1 delegate to the meeting. This is customarily the President of the Association, or another authorized member of the Board. *This applies to the Ministerial Association, Women Ministries Association, and Highrock Church Network* 

## People coming to give reports from agencies and associations need to register for the meeting.

You can only register as a delegate from one (1) Conference member church, agency, or association - so you can't double dip as a delegate. However, you can bring a report if you are a delegate from one entity and reporting about another entity. If you are not registering as a delegate representing your agency/association or your local church, you can register as a "guest" - but you will not be granted voting privileges. If you are a guest but are bringing a report to the meeting, please let us know so we can list you as "advisory" to the meeting, which will grant you voice in the business sessions.

Please keep in mind that being a delegate is a one year obligation - the "Annual Meeting" is our version of Congress, and those delegates elected, appointed, and registered from each member entity serve for a year in that role. If your church/agency/entity does not elect/appoint/register delegates, then you are unrepresented for the coming year in all gatherings of the Annual Meeting.
